- ❖ This Formation Workshop is a five-day experience from November 29 to December 3, 2021, providing new JPIC Promoters with the tools needed to animate members of their Congregation and/ or their place of ministry. It will start with "foundations" and elaborate on the theme of how Consecrated Life connects with the needs and concerns of the participants. The workshop will focus on the aspects of ministerial collaboration, communion and the synodal process.
