Dear Members of the Noailles Family,


Greetings!

GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE HOLY FAMILY SECULAR INSTITUTE



The Holy Family Secular Institute will hold its seventh General Assembly from 11 to 15 July 2022.

The theme: **Supported by Christ, let us Search for our Mission.**

Given the current pandemic situation, the difficulties of travel for the seculars and other situations, it has been decided to hold it telematically.

Seculars from the following countries will meet through the zoom platform: Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Congo, Spain, France, India, Ireland, Italy, Peru, Sri Lanka (Jaffna and Colombo) and South Africa.

The Superior General of the Apostolic Sisters and the Vicar of the Contemplative Sisters are invited to participate.

We have also invited the apostolic sisters from different countries who accompany the secular groups. They will have the right to speak but not the right to vote.

Eithne Hughes and María Lourdes de la Fuente are helping us in the preparation of the Assembly. Both will participate in it; one as Moderator and the other as Secretary.

In this ecclesial event, which is the Assembly, the past is reviewed and the future is focused on. The team that will lead the Institute in the next six years will also be renewed. The General Leader and the four General Counsellors will be elected.

We want to face this event with enthusiasm, considering how we should live our secular consecration, taking into account the changes that the world is presenting to us. Hence our theme: Supported by Christ, let us seek our mission. The Assembly will close on 26 July, the day on which the votes for the elections of the Leadership Team will be counted.
